

### PAIRING THE SPEAKER TO BLUETOOTH DEVICE

 Make sure the Bluetooth<sup>®</sup> function is available on your cell phone. Specific pairing procedures will be different depending on different cell phones. For detailed information, please refer to your cell phone's User Guide.

 After successful pairing, devices will memorize each other. Therefore no pairing will be needed the next time you power up your Speakers.

- 1. Keep the distance between the cell phone and the speaker within 3 feet ( for pairing only).
- 2. Turn on the speaker by pressing the "Power On/Off" button
- 3. The tone prompt will sound. The unit will automatically enter into pairing mode.
- Activate the Bluetooth function of the cell phone to search for the Bluetooth devices. After finishing the search, select "A1+" in the device list displayed.
- 5. Your A1+ speaker is ready to use.

### SPEAKER CONTROLS

ON/OFF

Press and release the Power On/Off button During a call or when listening to music **Volume +** Press and hold **+** Button.

VOLUME

Volume – Press and hold 🗖 Button. MUSIC Go to next song Long Press +

TF CARD MODE (automatic after inserting TF card)

### PLAY/PAUSE

Press Dto play/pause the music.

### TWS MODE

1. Turn off the Bluetooth mode on your mobile device.

- 2. Turn on the speakers by pressing the "Power On/Off" button
- 3. On either speaker, press and hold the "LED Flame On/Off" button for 3-5 seconds, and wait until you hear a "ding-dong" confirmation tone.

The speakers are now connected, and you can connect your Bluetooth device.

## LED FLAME

To use the LED flame function, press and release the LED Flame On/Off button once. The lamp will turn on to the dimmest setting. There are 3 brightness levels; press and release to change the brightness.

#### IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

Keep Speaker away from any heat source

• Always adjust the Speaker volume to a suitable level to avoid hearing damage or damage to the unit.

 If not using the Speaker for a long period of tie, keep the internal battery charged (charge once every 3 months). This will extend the life of your lithium battery.
